
WASTE RECEPTACLE STORAGE

Are you having a hard time finding space in your garage for your waste receptacles? The HOW Board of Directors have a solution for you!

A durable, plastic storage enclosure (neutral in color) can be used to enclose the waste containers outside of the garage. The storage unit must be able to house (2) ninety gallon waste receptacles and be located along the side of the garage, 5'-0" minimum from the front corner of the garage or in the back accessory area. The unit must be secure to the home and placed on a leveled foundation of concrete or large concrete pavers. One such garbage enclosure will be permitted outside the unit. All enclosures must be approved by the HOW Board of Directors prior to installation. Please see the HOW Rules and Regulations for more information.



The Suncast Stow-Away Plastic Storage Shed as shown above is an approved garbage receptacle storage unit.



HOW RULES AND REGULATIONS STORAGE SHEDS

Storage sheds are no longer required to be located in the accessory area of your home. The HOW Rules and Regulations has been updated to allow the shed to be located in the rear of the unit, a minimum of 6'-0" from the property line.

Reminder—all sheds require written approval from the Board of Directors prior to installation.

NO-BAKE RECIPE CHOCOLATE CORNFLAKE COOKIES

This recipe is easy and fun to make. It's crunchy, chocolatey and no-bake— You can't go wrong!

Equipment

- □ Cupcake Muffin Pan
- □ Greaseproof liners

Ingredients

- □ 1 1/4 cups of semi-sweet chocolate chips
- □ 1/2 cup creamy peanut butter
- □ Pinch of salt
- □ 1 cups of cornflakes
- □ 1/2 cut pastel M+Ms or your favorite chocolate candy



Instructions:

Line a cupcake pan with greaseproof liners and set aside. Microwave 1 1/4 cups chocolate chips and 1/2 cup of peanut butter on high for 30 seconds, stirring in between until melted. Add a pinch of salt and stir. Add 2 cups of cornflakes and stir until cornflakes are covered in chocolate. Scoop the mixture into your liners, top with M+Ms and chill in the refrigerator overnight or until set.
