HOW RULES AND REGULATIONS **EXTERIOR HOUSE LIGHTS**

Please make sure your garage lights are operational! The subdivision was built without street lights with the intention that the home-owners would have garage and porch lights on to provide safety in the dark. If you only have one exterior light at your garage, please leave your porch light on at night. If your garage lights aren't working even after you change the bulbs, then your sensor is bad. The sensor senses when it get dark enough to automatically turn on the lights. These sensors can be purchased at any local hardware or home improvement store. Avoid receiving a violation letter and light up your home!
